



Team and Player Responsibilities

In order to efficiently plan and execute an event of this size, it is necessary that all of the neighborhood teams follow a few guidelines.

The Teams will keep in mind that one of the most important purposes of this event is to lift the spirits and raise as much money as we can for a Cranberry resident in need.

- ❖ Each neighborhood team
 - Will designate at least one person as the “Representative”.
 - The neighborhood Representative will be a liaison between the tournament organizers and their neighborhoods and will distribute and communicate all additional information.
 - The Representative will provide the opportunity for any current resident of their neighborhood to participate on their team.
 - The neighborhood Representative will ensure that their team meets all due dates for registration and raffle.
 - The Representative will ensure that all players are over the age of 18 and a resident (at the time of registration) of the neighborhood that they are playing for.
 - The Teams are required to sell 100 raffle tickets.
 - The Teams are required to attend the Opening Ceremony.
 - The Representative will ensure that all players have received the rules and maintain dignity and good behavior through out the event.
