## Rules and Regulations

**All Participants must be over 18 years of age and pay the \$500 registration fee through sponsorships or private donations prior to the preliminary round on August 27th Please make all checks payable to "The Cranberry CUP"**

### **SPACE IS LIMITED, SO REGISTER EARLY!**

- **Cranberry Township Division** - Anyone over 18 who was on a Cranberry Cup Neighborhood or Open division team or a resident within the Seneca Valley School District
- **Regional Division** – Anyone over 18 who meet the above fundraising requirements

The participant can provide their own pitcher (Highly Recommended)

**No restrictions on bats.** Bring your favorite bat of any make or model.

**No ASA restrictions.**

Batter cannot take three pitches in a row (if you have taken 2 pitches, you must swing at the 3rd)

Each participant gets 10 outs before they must sit down.

An out is any swing that does not result in a fair Home Run

Top 8 in Round 1 move on to Round 2. Order determined by Homeruns hit in Round 1

Top 4 in Round 2 move on to Final Round within bracket. Player with most Homeruns in first 2 rounds bats last.

**Top 2 in each division in Round 3 are invited to PNC Park for Final Round on 9/5/11. In the event of a tiebreaker after the final round, both batters will receive a fresh 5 outs. Order determined by coin toss.**

**Top fundraiser from each bracket receives automatic invitation to Final Round at PNC Park.**

Player with the most Home Runs in the Final Round at PNC Park is the Home Run Champion and receives the Grand Prize

- *Cranberry Cup Home Run Derby Commissioner is the final arbiter for all rule interpretations. Disagreement is cause for elimination from the event.*
