## Jason Koliscak Good Friday Golf Classic

In 2014, the Cranberry CUP community rallied around Jason Koliscak as he battled chronic liver disease and bile duct cancer. Grateful for the support he received, Jason was inspired to give back, founding the Jason Koliscak Good Friday Golf Outing in 2016. Although he passed away just three months after the inaugural event, his legacy of generosity and community spirit lives on.

In his memory, his wife, Melanie, and their daughters continue the tradition through the annual Cranberry CUP Jason Koliscak Golf Classic, now in its 9th year. Held at Olde Stonewall Golf Club, the event has become a meaningful staple in the community.

This year's outing was especially significant, as Jason's daughter Addison led the event as part of her senior project, honoring her father in a deeply personal way. With the support of volunteers and generous donations, including a successful silent auction, the event continues to grow in impact.

Through the dedication of the Koliscak family, volunteers, and supporters, the Cranberry CUP raises vital funds each year to assist local families facing financial and medical hardships - ensuring Jason's legacy of compassion, community, and giving endures.
