



Cranberry CUP Team and Player Responsibilities

In order to efficiently plan and execute an event of this size, it is necessary that all of the neighborhood teams follow a few guidelines. The teams will keep in mind that one of the most important purposes of this event is to lift the spirits and raise as much money as we can for Seneca Valley district families in need.

- Each neighborhood team will designate at least one person as the “TEAM REP”
- The TEAM REP will serve as liaison between their neighborhood and tournament organizers and will distribute and communicate all pertinent information in a timely manner
- The TEAM REP will provide the opportunity for any current resident of their neighborhood to participate on their team.
- The TEAM REP will ensure that their team meets all due dates for registration and raffle.
- The TEAM REP will ensure that all players are over the age of 18 and a resident (at the time of the tournament) of the neighborhood for whom they are playing.
- All teams are required to sell 100 raffle tickets.
- All teams are required to attend the Opening Ceremony.
- The TEAM REP will ensure that all players have received and have read the tournament rules and will ensure that dignity and sportsman-like behavior prevails throughout the tournament.
